- Do not want to be responsible for managing a facility; perhaps assisting a currently-operating facility
- The focus of sister parish focus or local focus must be decided
- Our parish could also be a part of local efforts as opposed to service trips; boots on the ground
- Be valuable for those who do not have the financial needs to support to help in some way
- We can invite a wide variety of people to help serve; community-building

Education

- A committee will be formed in the near future to address the lighting system
